Senator Cropsey offered the following amendments to Senate Bill No. 1107 (S-1, Draft 3):

1. Amend page 199, line 17, after "(1)," by striking out "\$23,800,000.00" and inserting "\$23,100,000.00".

2. Amend page 206, line 5, after "section." by inserting

"HOWEVER, FROM THE AMOUNT ALLOCATED UNDER SUBSECTION (1), UP TO A MAXIMUM OF \$700,000.00 SHALL BE MADE AVAILABLE AS COMPETITIVE GRANTS TO DISTRICTS THAT ENROLL ADULTS WHO DO NOT HAVE A HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA OR G.E.D. AND WHO ARE INCARCERATED IN A STATE CORRECTIONAL FACILITY IN GENERAL EDUCATION DEVELOPMENT (G.E.D.) TEST PREPARATION COURSES AND WORKSHOPS OR HIGH SCHOOL COMPLETION PROGRAMS. DISTRICTS APPLYING FOR GRANTS UNDER THIS SUBSECTION SHALL DO SO IN A FORM AND MANNER DETERMINED BY THE DEPARTMENT. DISTRICTS RECEIVING FUNDING UNDER THIS SUBSECTION SHALL PROVIDE G.E.D. AND HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA PROGRAMS SUBSTANTIALLY SIMILAR TO THOSE PROGRAMS AS DESCRIBED IN THIS SECTION, AND SHALL RECEIVE \$2,850.00 PER PARTICIPANT ENROLLED IN THE PROGRAMS."
